



# How to Sort and Dispose of Household Garbage



Garbage must be placed at your designated collection sites by 8:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day.

Garbage collection schedules of each items are based on your address.

## Burnable Garbage

Twice a week

Every \_\_\_ day & \_\_\_ day

You must use garbage bags designated by Mishima City.



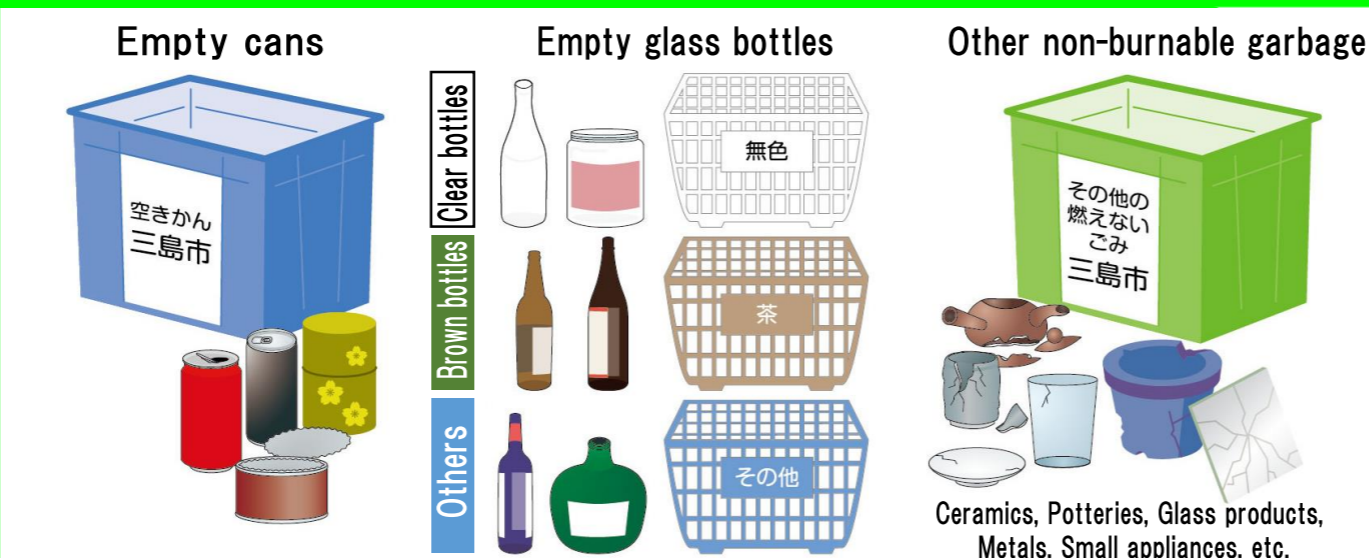
- Kitchen waste must be drained off any excess water.
- Must be 30cm or less on one side.  
Note: Folded or rolled garbage less than 30 cm in length CANNOT be disposed.
- Tree branches (cut garden trees) of less than 50 cm in length and 10 cm in diameter can be placed at your collection sites.  
Note: Please tie the branches into a bundle with strings.

## Recyclable Refuse

Twice a month

The \_\_\_ & \_\_\_ day of every month

They must be placed in the designated containers at your collection sites.

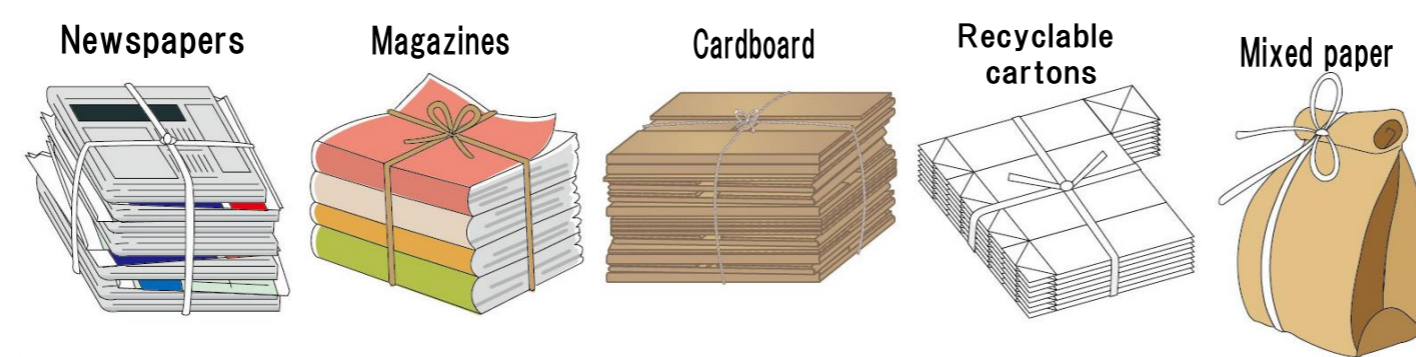


- Cans and bottles need to be emptied and rinsed clean.
- Plastic caps are "Burnable garbage." Metal caps are "Other non-burnable garbage."
- Spray cans are "Dangerous garbage".
- "Other non-burnable garbage" must be less than 50 cm on one side.  
Note: They can be disposed if folded or rolled up to less than 50 cm on one side.

## Recyclable Paper

Twice a month

The \_\_\_ & \_\_\_ day of every month



- Recyclable paper excepting Mixed used paper must be tied up together with twine. (Please do not tie them up with plastic strings or gummed tape.)
- Mixed used paper can be placed in paper bags or transparent plastic bags.
- We would appreciate if you could avoid rainy days to recycle paper.

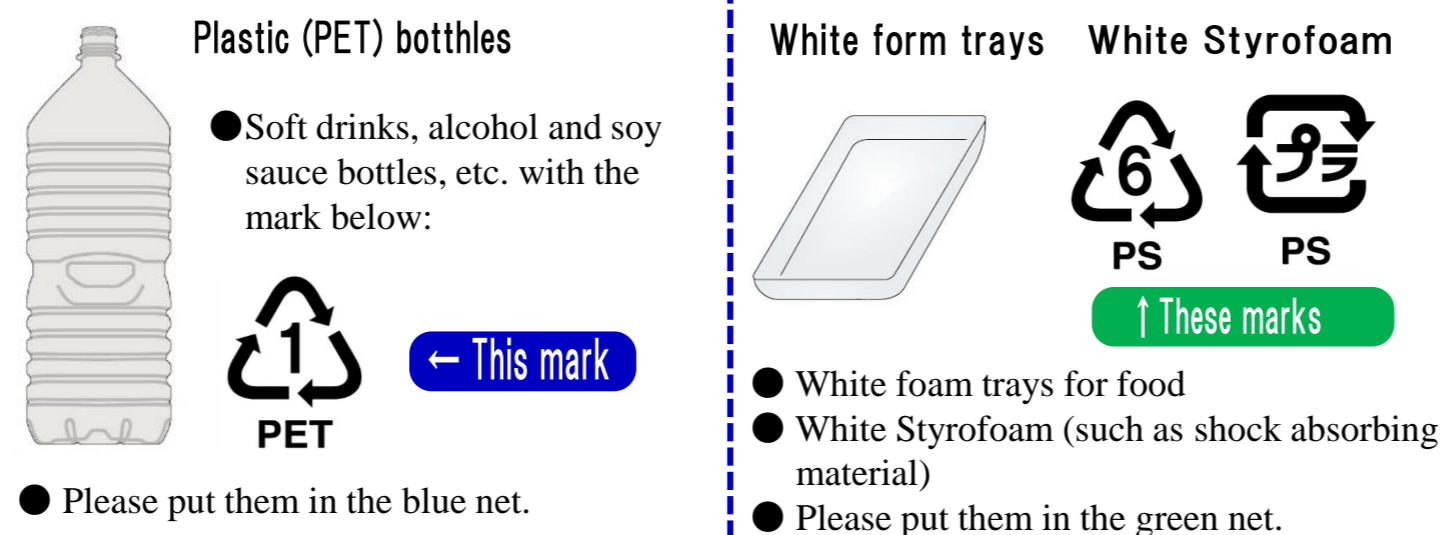
- Mixed paper: All paper except newspapers, magazines, cardboard, and recyclable cartons. Examples: paper bags, wrapping paper, envelopes, photographs, and other paper products, such as shredded or torn pieces of paper.
- Paper with vinyl, aluminum foil, paper clips or metal fittings CAN be recycled.
- Extremely dirty paper, paper soaked in oil or water or paper with strong odor must be sorted into "Burnable garbage".

## Plastic(PET) Bottles White Form Trays White Styrofoam

Twice a month

The \_\_\_ & \_\_\_ day of every month

They must be placed in the designated containers at your collection sites.



- Soft drinks, alcohol and soy sauce bottles, etc. with the mark below:  
 ← This mark
- Please put them in the blue net.

- White foam trays for food
- White Styrofoam (such as shock absorbing material)
- Please put them in the green net.

- (Plastic(PET) bottles)
- Please rinse them out and crush them with your foot.
- Caps and labels must be removed and sorted into "Burnable garbage".
- (White form trays) (White Styrofoam )
- Must to be cleaned before recycling.
- If parts of trays are colored or printed, they must be sorted into "Burnable garbage".

## Dangerous Garbage

Once a month

The \_\_\_ Friday of every month



- Spray cans must be emptied and disposed without been pierced a hole.
- Light bulbs and fluorescent bulbs must be put into separate boxes, and edged tools must be wrapped with newspaper, etc.

## Clothes

(Designated Recycling Boxes)

- Clothes Recycling Boxes are located in 14 places including the City Hall, gymnasium, community centers, etc.
- Clothes which is not cut into pieces smaller than 30 cm CANNOT be collected as burnable garbage. They must be placed into Clothes Recycling Box.

## Batteries

- There is no designated collection day for batteries, you can put them in the collection container at anytime.
- Put them separately into the collection container placed at the designated collecting sites.
- Button cells and rechargeable batteries, such as nickel-cadmium and lithium ion batteries, etc. CANNOT be collected. They need to be taken to retail stores.

## Over-sized Garbage

- "Burnable Garbage over 30 cm in length
- "Other non-burnable garbage" over 50 cm in length
- Bring them to Waste Management Center or schedule an individual pickup. ( Fees will apply)

**Furniture and Electric appliances**  
Except TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washers, and dryers

**Bicycles, Oil stoves, etc.**

**Hours**

- Monday to Friday (except national holidays) or the 1st Sunday of every month.
- [Morning] 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m.
- [Afternoon] 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

\* We need to verify your address, so please bring your ID with your current address.

**TVs, Air Conditioners, Refrigerators, Freezers, Washers, Dryers, CRT monitors, and CRT all-in-one computers.**

**CANNOT be processed at the Waste Management Center**

**Arrange for them to be picked up by the retailer where they were originally purchased.**

**Over-sized Garbage Pickup Service**

**Fees : 2,000 yen/pickup**

- Over-sized Garbage less than 100 kg can be collected at your home.
- They must be placed outside of your door before the pickup. We will NOT carry them out your home.
